93% of Valencia's Associate in Science/Applied Science degree graduates (2004/2005) are placed in jobs earning an average annual salary of \$37,088.

84.5% of Valencia AA graduates who transferred to the Florida State University System in 2005/2006 continued their studies at the University of Central Florida.
