MAXIMUM AWARD OF CREDIT

This agreement makes it possible for a student to receive 22 – 28 semester hours of college credit towards the Criminal Justice Technology A.A.S. Degree program and 12 – 15 semester hours of college credit towards the Criminal Justice Technology A.S. Degree program at Valencia Community College, which is in accordance with commonly accepted good practice in higher education.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

Valencia’s faculty and staff who have responsibility for the supervision and coordination of the Criminal Justice Technology program have assessed the adequacy of the documentation and determined that the learning outcomes, performance standards, and assessment procedures of the examination meet the college standards for college credit course work and that the learning outcomes are consistent with the course work in the A.S. Degree being articulated and that the state licensure exam required meets the criteria and measures of the learning outcomes of the program.

AWARD OF CREDIT PROCESS

The transferring student must submit a copy of their Licensure/Certification as a Correctional Officer, Law Enforcement Officer or Probation/Parole Officer from a State Recognized Training Academy Program and qualified Certification Examination.

To have the articulation agreement credits reported on the official Valencia Community College transcript, the student must:

1. Meet regular College entrance requirements.
2. Complete the College Application and pay the College Admission Fee.
3. Declare a major in the Criminal Justice Technology A.S. or A.A.S. degree program.
4. Comply with the appropriate placement, course prerequisites and requirements of the college.
5. Successfully complete at least six (6) college credit hours at Valencia with a "C" or better while currently enrolled on either a part-time or full-time basis for one academic term to have the credit awarded on the official college transcript.
6. The Dean for IT, Business and Public Services, East Campus at Valencia, and the Program Director for Criminal Justice Technology, East Campus, at Valencia will evaluate the student's licensure/certification to determine eligibility and notify the Registrar's Office of acceptable credit to be transferred and awarded.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

This agreement applies to students who have completed a State Mandated Training Academy Program and been granted certification as a Correctional Officer, Law Enforcement Officer or Probation/Parole Officer through a recognized and qualified Certification Examination. The agreement will be reviewed as needed and it shall remain in effect until either party identifies a need for revision.
