### Elaine Tagliareni, Ed.D, RN

Wednesday, May 16

Elaine Tagliareni is a professor and the Independence Foundation Chair in Community Health Nursing Education at the Community College of Philadelphia. After earning her bachelor's degree in Nursing from Georgetown University, Tagliareni pursued her master's degree in Mental Health and Community Nursing from the University of California at San Francisco and obtained a doctorate from Columbia University's Teacher's College. Her doctoral work focused on the role of the nurse educator in community colleges. She has been involved with associate degree programs through out her entire career. Elaine has led a major national effort to integrate gerontology into curricula and to assist faculty in re-conceptualizing student-teacher partnerships. Elaine is President-Elect of the National League for Nursing (NLN), 2005-2007.

## POST-SUMMIT WORKSHOP

### Simulation & Scenario Development

Simulation has been utilized by nursing for years. We have used standardized patients, models and static mannequins to assist students in learning basic skills. The new Hi-fidelity simulators add an exciting, dynamic, element to assessments and simulated experiences. This workshop is intended to demonstrate theory-based learning using hi-fidelity simulation. An emphasis will be placed on scenario development and planning with an example of implementation of a simple scenario. Participants will be able to experience the student perspective.
