

*Vision, Values, and Mission Task Force
Minutes for Tuesday, 13 February 2007
9:00 a.m. East – Room 8-105D*

1. **Welcome & review of minutes**

The minutes from the January 16 meeting of the task force were approved.

2. **Feedback to the Vision, Values, & Mission Draft**

Emailed comments on the Vision, Values, and Mission statements were reviewed, along with the status of college-wide discussions. The draft statements are widely available on all campuses, but there was some question of their visibility, as received comments numbered only a few.

Specific concerns in the comments were addressed, and additional edits of the Vision and Mission statements were shared. Since concerns with the existing draft statements remain limited and non-specific at this point, the edits were tabled with the caveat that the statements remain in draft form. The discussion and revision process remains open.

The Communications Task Force will be contacted for an update, as their next meeting is scheduled for Friday, 16 February.

3. **Discussion: The Statutory Purpose**

A handout of Florida Statute 1004.65 was shared. This chapter specifically addresses the mission of Florida community colleges. The existing Statutory Purpose statement listed in the college catalog and online appears to be a paraphrase of this statute. The Task Force recommended the addition of a reference to Florida Statute 1004.65.

4. **Evaluation of the VVM Task Force**

Task Force members are asked to review the General Draft Questions prepared by the Evaluation Design Team and compose responses to be shared with David Rogers by Tuesday, February 20. All responses will be compiled and shared with the task force for revisions and edits. The final evaluation report will be shared with the Planning Council meeting on Thursday, 22 Feb.
