Veteran Affairs

Contact the Office of Veteran Affairs on your campus to obtain proper applications and advising concerning your particular type of educational benefits. We will process your application for you to the Veterans Administration. Or you may apply online www.va.gov . If you apply online our office will need a copy of the online application.

Certification Request

Once you have registered for your classes complete your VA certification request. You may obtain this either on campus or online. To file online visit Valencia's web site. Click on student services where you will find the Veteran Affairs page. Navigate to the certification request. Submit as an email to the Office of Veteran Affairs. This procedure is necessary each semester.

60 Day Deferment

New students are eligible to apply for a 60 day deferment. This will allow an additional 60 days to pay the business office your tuition fees. You will need to sign a promissory note in the VA office on campus. Once signed the original must be submitted to the Business Office in order to finish this process. Please note that it is the student's responsibility to pay for your tuition fees on or before the promissory note dead line.
